



Dr. Denise Oleksijczuk is an associate professor for the school of Contemporary Arts at Simon Fraser University in Vancouver. Her book, *The First Panoramas*, has just been released by the University of Minnesota Press.

Landon Mackenzie is a practicing artist and full Professor at Emily Carr University of Art + Design where she has taught since 1986 in painting and drawing. She is best known for her large format paintings which combine layers of information often from history and science while still being grounded in a reference to landscape. Her work has been written about extensively and she continues to exhibit in Canada and internationally.

Carol-Ann Ryan is an instructor of art history, whose academic interests focus on modern and contemporary art practices, especially Canadian painting. Before moving to Vancouver, she taught at the University of Toronto, the Ontario College of Art & Design, and led education and outreach programs at the Museum of Contemporary Canadian Art in Toronto. Currently, Carol-Ann volunteers with the Contemporary Art Society of Vancouver.
